Next Sunday afternoon at 4:00 pm, Harbor Church will host a **Poetry Reading and Book Signing** by former RI Poet Laureate **Lisa Starr** and Georgia poet **Coleman Barks**, best known for his translations of Rumi. Co-sponsored by Island Bound Book Store.

This Friday, July 21st, at 7:00 p.m. the **Common Ground Coffeehouse** presents jazz singer and composer **Sarah Brindell** in the sanctuary. There will be no coffeehouse in terms of food or drink, just a concert in the sanctuary. Sarah teaches at the Berklee School of Music in Boston and has been a teacher of Cameron Greenlee. She performs a melodious blend of Soul, Jazz, Bossa Nova, Reggae, Pop and R&B that captivates audiences around the world.
