This program is presented in connection with the display at the Island Free Library. On Tuesday, August 15, at 7:30 Jim Wallis will give a response to a showing of the film *I Am Not Your Negro*, based on James Baldwin's friendships with Martin, Medgar, and Malcolm and his view of the civil rights movement and the situation of black Americans.

This Friday, August 11, at 7:00 p.m. the **Common Grounds Coffeehouse** presents **Will Houlihan** of Haunt the House. Will lives in the woods of Charlestown, in a quiet place where he thinks deeply and writes evocative songs. He lists his genre(s) as "devotional Americana experimental folk." There's a mix of rootsy bluegrass with gospel, including a song about Jesus and one about a hymnal. Weather permitting, the coffeehouse will be on the front porch and lawn.
