This **Monday, August 14, 500 Years**, a documentary film about Guatemala and progress since the fall of its genocidal dictator, will premiere at the Island Free Library at **6:00 p.m.** The film will be shown in English in one room and in Spanish in the adjacent room. Then all will join for a reception and Q&A with the filmmakers Peter Kinoy (a summer resident), Pamela Yates, and Paco de Onis. This event is sponsored by Harbor Church and Ministerios Nuevo Pacto along with the Library.

We will show the film *I Am Not Your Negro*, based on novelist James Baldwin's notes for his last book about his friends Martin, Medgar, and Malcolm, on **Tuesday, August 15, at 7:30 p.m.** The film features many powerful clips of Baldwin's own take on the civil rights movement and the situation of blacks in the US. Jim Wallis of Sojourners, whose last book dealt with racism as *America's Original Sin*, will give a response to the film, as will Elliot Taubman, who served for a time as Baldwin's attorney and knew him well.

On Wednesday, August 16 at 7:00 p.m. Cameron's music series at the St. Andrew Parish Center will feature the Cuban jazz of **HAROLD LÓPEZ-NUSSA**, whose recent album hit #1 on iTunes' jazz chart and #2 on Amazon's. Will Young recruited this Trio to come to Block Island—a smaller venue than they usually play, e.g. the Kennedy Center and the Montreaux, Montreal, and Tokyo Jazz Festivals. Be there!

This Friday, August 18, at 7:00 p.m. the **Common Grounds Coffeehouse** presents a **fantastic DOUBLE BILL: Carrie Johnson and Mark Cutler.** Carrie is a songwriter from CT who has recorded several CDs solo and with her sister Libby. Mark is one of the stalwarts of the Rhode Island rock scene for over three decades, and a member of the RI Music Hall of Fame. Weather permitting, the coffeehouse will be on the front porch and lawn. You are also invited to join us at 6:30 for dinner with the international students.
