After months have passed without a culprit in her daughter's murder case, a grieving and angry mother makes a bold move, painting three signs leading into her town with a controversial message directed at the town's revered chief of police. The film earned seven Oscar nominations, including Best Picture, Best Original Screenplay, and performances by Frances McDormand as the mother and Woody Harrelson as the chief. (Rated R for violence, language throughout, and some sexual references.) As always, a supper will be served at 6:30 p.m., coffee and dessert just before the film.
