Live music returns to our Common Ground Coffeehouse this week! Singer, songwriter and guitarist **John Fuzek** begins the season this Friday, May 4. John features classic covers and original songs with a folk sound in his travels around New England and elsewhere in the US. He has performed at the coffeehouse several times and helped organize our BeatleFest event on Columbus Day weekend in 2015, 2016 and 2017. John is also organizing a Farewell Folk Festival in Pastor Steve's honor for Sunday, July 29; more details to come.

Next up, May 11, Allysen Callery; May 18, Ed McGuirl and movie, *Every Brilliant Thing* (see below); May 25, Carrie Johnson and Peter Preiser (this will be Pastor Candidate's Weekend). The June schedule includes Krista Baroni, Cardboard Ox, Cameron Greenlee and Kala Farnham. Please sign up in the Fellowship Hall to bring soup or a simple entrée, or dessert, for a coffeehouse night.

On May 18, NAMI Block Island's annual Spring Conference (for Mental Health Month) will kick off at Common Ground Coffeehouse with music by folksinger and therapist Ed McGuirl and the showing of a film, *Every Brilliant Thing*. Jonny Donahoe performs in a one-person play about a man who came of age with a suicidal mother but, at various stages of his life, set about compiling a long list of reasons to live. Filmed at the Barrow Street Theatre in New York City in 2015, it's 61 minutes. The *New York Times* wrote, *Mr. Donahoe's heartfelt performance earns him the credibility to speak on a difficult subject. And, surprisingly, the show is full of humor, not to mention delightful audience participation.*

As usual, there will be supper at 6:30, followed by an introduction of the conference and the theme of Depression, then the movie, followed by songs and discussion led by Ed McGuirl. On Saturday, May 19, the conference will continue with three speakers and a panel at the Island Free Library, 9:30 am to 5:30 pm.

We will begin a new series of Lunch Bible Studies on Wednesday, May 2, at 12:00 noon. We'll have discussions based on a new book by Walter Brueggemann, *Interrupting Silence: God's Command to Speak Out*. Copies of the book are available in the foyer for \$10 (if you can afford it).
