Live music is back for our Common Ground Coffeehouse spring season! **Allysen Callery** will bring her “ghost folk” guitar sound and her original songs on this Friday, May 11, at 7:15 p.m. She has played at our coffeehouse each year since 2012, in between performing at festivals and venues including South by Southwest (in Austin, TX), the Newport Folk Festival, and in the UK, Germany, and Switzerland. She plays guitar “finger style,” picking melody and harmony, and has a soft but clear voice reminiscent of the folk revival of the 70’s. Supper and dessert is served at 6:30 p.m. each week; music begins at 7:15 p.m. Please sign up in the Fellowship Hall to bring soup or a simple entrée, or dessert, for a coffeehouse night.

On Friday, May 18, **NAMI Block Island’s annual Spring Conference** (for Mental Health Month) will kick off at Common Ground Coffeehouse with music by folksinger and therapist Ed McGuirl and the showing of a film, ***Every Brilliant Thing***. As usual, there will be supper at 6:30, followed by an introduction of the conference and the theme of Depression, then the movie, followed by songs and discussion led by Ed McGuirl. On Saturday, May 19, the conference will continue with three speakers and a panel at the Island Free Library, 9:30 am to 5:30 pm.

A new series of **Lunch Bible Studies** continues Wednesday, May 9, at 12:00 noon. We’ll have discussions based on a new book by Walter Brueggemann, *Interrupting Silence: God’s Command to Speak Out*. Copies of the book are available in the foyer for \$10 (if you can afford it).

On Monday, May 21, at 7:30 p.m., he will present a concert including music by Bach, Vivaldi, Franck, Hilse, and Mulet. Memorial Day Weekend will be **Candidate’s Weekend** sponsored by our Pastoral Search Committee. Rev. Peter Preiser will be presented at the coffeehouse on Friday night, May 25, with time for questions and answers.
