1. Kick-off (January/February)

We will begin by considering what life is like for a child living in poverty. We will look at ways in which we can partner with Compassion International, and also by supporting our local food bank, Helping Hands.

Families can visit www.compassion.com/livecompassion if they wish to donate and provide food for a hungry child for a month or make one-time gifts. These go to the Where Most Needed fund and will be used to better serve millions of children in extreme poverty, specifically in situations like Homelessness, Emergency Medical Treatment, and Natural Disaster Relief.

2. Pray for Specific Children in Need. (March/April)

Once our kids and families begin to see what a child living in poverty experiences, we will offer them opportunities to pray for specific children!

3. Participate in Compassion Sunday. (May)

At the end of six weeks, We will celebrate what we have learned, make a special donation to this ministry, and decide if we as a church would like to sponsor a child on an ongoing basis.
